

A call for solidarity following the earthquake in Colombia: Support the reconstruction of La Salle Pereira!

Following the worst earthquake to hit Colombia in recent decades — measuring 7.4 on the Richter scale — which struck the west of the country particularly hard on 10 August, leaving a death toll of at least 294 to date, 320 people missing and more than 115,000 people directly affected, as well as severe material damage and collapsed infrastructure - **La Salle is appealing for global solidarity.**

Two Lasallian educational ministries in the affected area have been impacted, and one of them, **Colegio La Salle Pereira, has suffered severe damage that jeopardises its reopening and the continuity of its mission.**

Without urgent intervention, the 362 students at Colegio La Salle Pereira risk being unable to return to their classrooms!

The Lasallian network in Colombia — through the Norandino and Bogotá Lasallian Districts — is mobilising to support the affected communities, collecting and distributing goods and humanitarian aid to those who have lost their homes or find themselves in emergency situations.
