

Madagascar - Entrance Rite for five young Postulants

On Friday, October 15, 2021, at 5:30 p.m., was celebrated the official Mass for the nine postulants. Five will be in their first year and four in their second year, at the community of Saint Miguel de Soavimbahoaka. During this celebration, crucifixes were given by Brother Julien Ratsimbazafy, FSC, Visitor to the five first year postulants, as a sign of their first response to God's call in the Congregation of the Brothers of the Christian Schools.
