## New appointment for CIAMEL

Brother Armin Luistro, Superior General of the Brothers of the Christian Schools, has appointed Ms María Eugenia Quinodoz as a member of the International Council for Association and the Lasallian Educational Mission (CIAMEL), from 20 May 2025 until 14 May 2028.

*Entre Ríos* region (Argentina). She also teaches Educational Psychology, and Fundamentals and Principles of Psycho-Pedagogical evaluation at the Catholic University of Argentina.

Regarding her new appointment, Maria comments that "the invitation to join CIAMEL fills me with joy and at the same time with the desire to learn and continue to grow in order to contribute to the mission bestowed to us by our Holy Founder".
