Closeness and solidarity

In a Statement, the La Salle Educational Network - which includes the Antillas-Mexico Sur District and the Mexico Norte District - has expressed its **“solidarity with the people and communities who today suffer fear, grief and uncertainty”**, while supporting “the authorities in their work to pacify different areas and territories in the country”.

“As Lasallian educational works, we reaffirm that peace is a greater good for our coexistence,” reads the statement, which also affirms that **“educating implies forming people with clear ethical criteria, committed to the common good and to the construction of just societies that promote peace.”**
