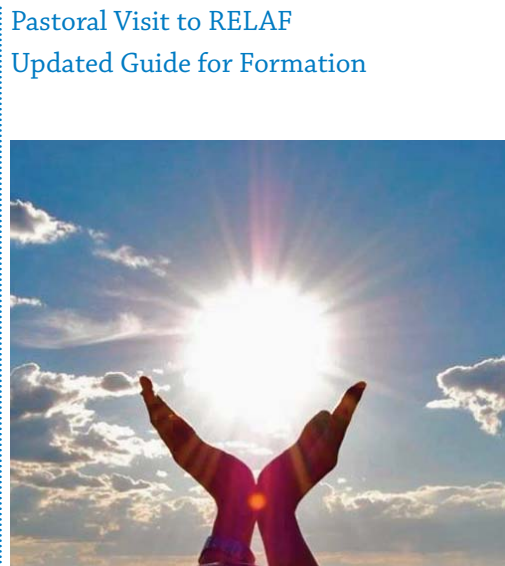

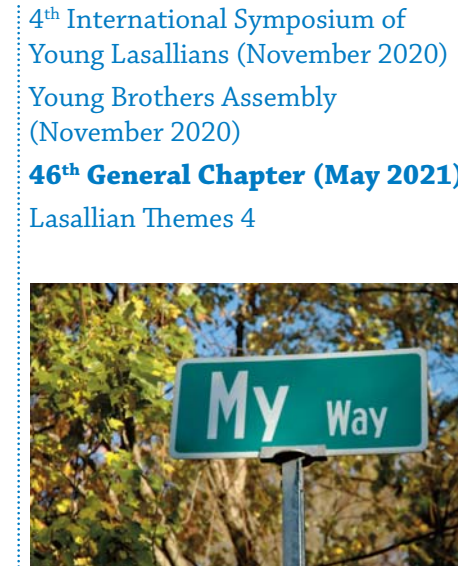

Sundays and Feasts.



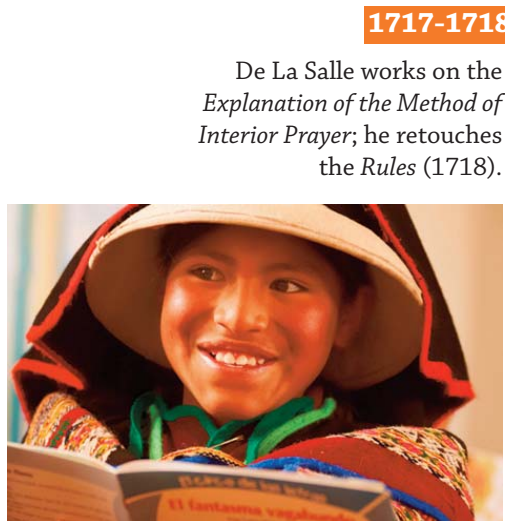
