De La Salle moves to Saint-Yon (Nov. 1715). He continues working on the Meditations for Sundays and Feasts.

1716-1717

Br. Barthélemy visits the communities to prepare the General Chapter. He is elected Superior General at the 2^{nd} General Chapter (1717).

1717-1718

De La Salle works on the Explanation of the Method of Interior Prayer; he retouches the Rules (1718).


