## Called to Prophetic Audacity

"Men and women must live and create. We must live intensely. We must always live on the verge of tears. Without emotion there is no life". Albert Camus, like many poets, expresses a lot of wisdom in a few words. To be on the margins, to move towards the peripheries, to go out of the comfort zones is certainly a way of living intensely and, above all, for those of us who decide to follow Jesus Christ, it is the only way to be consistent with the calls of God and of history.

The General Chapter called it 'prophetic audacity' in view to invite us to listen to the call of the young people and the cry of the poor, and to move us to a mission more consistent with our history and with the realities of the world in which we live. Audacity implies risk, movement and generosity; and prophetism provides us with the key to following Jesus Christ: denouncing evil and calling for hope in a mission more consistent with our founding story and our commitments.

Schools, in his message of 4 June 2023 - on the occasion of the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity - will take place at the Generalate in Rome from 7 to 14 July 2024, and is placed in the communal perspective of the journey of conversion which requires "significant changes in our organisation on the level of the central government of our Institute", in a way that "will allow us to **build on the gains of the past, to be more dynamic in responding to the emerging needs of the world, and facilitate our discernment and implementation of the inspirations from the Holy Spirit"**, as Br Armin said in his message.


