Fraternal greetings of peace and joy! We are pleased to announce the creation of the Institute Publications Committee which will work closely with our two Institute Offices, Lasallian Heritage & Research and Information & Communication.

The main functions of the International Publications Committee are the following:

1. Determine the editorial lines and collections to be carried out during the next five years, e.g., *Cahiers Lasalliens*, Lasallian Studies, MEL Bulletins, Bulletin of the Institute, Lasallian Reflections;
2. Assess the current and emerging needs of the global Lasallian Family in the area of publications and provide regular feedback to the Institute Councils and Offices for continuous improvement of available resources; and,
3. Recommend to the Superior General and Institute Councils the thrusts and overall priorities, directions and medium of dissemination for Lasallian publications.

We recognize the need to be more deliberate and focused on the priority themes and key messages that are at the heart of our Lasallian publications. Each Lasallian resource is a privileged instrument to communicate the mandate of the 46<sup>th</sup> General Chapter and III AIMEL so we can journey together in creative fidelity and heroic audacity. We also need to consider the contributions we could make to the ongoing reflections in the Church and the world.
